Benmore statistics	13 incidents in total for the dates 26/9/16 to 20/11/16
	3 Burglary – One incident in Hillmount Gardens at beginning of October. A number of males were disturbed while loading items in to a car. The car sped off towards Finaghy Road South with boot open. A number of items were taken including ipads, drills, etc. Forensics attended but found nothing. Follow up door to door enquiries have occurred but no further information added. Another incident in Locksley Park on 11 th Oct where house was entered while parent was carrying out school run in the morning. Rear door was damaged upon entry and laptops, tablet, speaker and jewellery taken. No CCTV and no witnesses. Tracker was on laptop and showed laptop to be in Newtownards but not specific enough with address. Incident in Locksley Park on 12 th October. House being renovated. Rear door was forced. Tools and bathroom suite were taken. A leaflet drop has been carried out around this area warning residents to be more vigilant.
	4 ASB – One incident in Benmore Drive where eggs and milkshake poured through a letterbox. One incident in Torr Way where up to 6 teenagers were throwing stones at windows. One incident in Locksley Park where a woman was being harassed by youths. Parents of youths spoken to. No further reports on this. One incident in Garron Crescent where eggs were thrown at a house. Perceived to be a hate crime. No CCTV or witnesses.
	2 Criminal Damage – One incident in Locksley Park. Attempted burglary in vacant property. Tool marks, possibly crowbar, on door where they have attempted to force it open. Side gate also broken. No CCTV or witnesses. One incident in Locksley Park where windows have been damaged, possibly by a pellet gun. Also small hole in front door. This was reported for information only.
	4 Suspicious – Locksley Park on 18 th October. Suspicious car reported with number of males in it. Stopped by police and all ok. Locksley Park on 19 th October. Male observed by a house owner using torch on his mobile phone to look around their property. This male was followed by a resident down as far as Stockman's Lane. Locksley Gardens had a male call to an elderly female's house asking her to sign up for a charity. The lady passed over her bank details but later cancelled the direct debit upon a change of heart. Charity found to be genuine.

	A resident in Innishowen Drive reported hearing her rear door being shaken and dog barking.
Erinvale statistics	3_ incidents in total for the dates 26/9/16 to 20/11/16 1 ASB – Egg thrown at window. No further reports. 2 Suspicious – One of these reports was a telephone scam trying to obtain details about car accidents. Caller told to contact Action Fraud. Another report was in Hollymount where people were calling door to door offering fabric softner and offering to clean carpets for free. Nothing found by police and no money was handed over.
